## ABSTRACT

The Project Started as a Pilot allotted by Govt. of India where under 4 Applied Skills (2 Applied Skills in each school) were introduced in 40 schools in 2012-13 and currently Vocational Education is covered in 1074 Schools with 14 Skills namely IT/ITeS, Retail, Security, Automobile, Beauty & Wellness, Patient Care Assistant, Physical Education & Sports, Agriculture, Media Entertainment/Animation, Travel & Tourism, Health Care (Vision-Technician), Apparel-Fashion Designer, Banking & Finance Services, Banking & Insurance Services. In this paper focussed on the implementation of vocational education in alignment with NSQF and also discussed good practices in vocational education and training which are establishment of incubation centre, Broadcasting NSQF Videos of Course Content through EDUSAT and Convergence of Inclusive Education for Differently Abled Children (IED) students into Vocational Education.
